








My-Kap® Filter Folding Instructions

#	Picture	Description
1		Take one of the filter papers.
2		Fold one edge over to meet the other edge. The fold point should be between the points labeled “a” in instruction #1 above.
3		Fold the edge where the two edges meet back about 1 ½ inch. The fold point should be between the points labeled “b” in instruction #2 above. The bottom edges should line up.
4		Fold the bottom up to make a flat side about the diameter of the bottom of a K-Cup. The fold point should be at the point labeled “c” in instruction #3 above. Don’t worry; you don’t have to be very precise.
5		Place the filter in the cup so that the hole in the bottom is oriented as shown. CAUTION: Don’t put the paper on top of the hole (that is the main thing to watch for).
6		Open the filter up so that it fills the K-Cup. One folded edge should fit snugly against the edge of the K-Cup.
7		Here is a different view. Notice the filter paper is above the K-Cup edge just a little bit. Now just fill the K-Cup with your favorite brew and use it as you normally would with a My-Kap Kap. Try this first without coffee and make sure it works for you.
