








## My-Kap® Kap Instructions








#	Picture	Description
1		Start with one of your favorite K-Cup coffees or teas and brew yourself a cup.
2		When you are done brewing you now have a K-Cup that has been punctured in the top and the bottom of the cup.
3		Peel the tin foil off of the K-Cup.
4		Either: A.) Wash the coffee or tea grounds out of the K-Cup AND LEAVE the filter in the K-Cup <sup>1</sup> OR, B.) Wash the coffee or tea grounds out of the K-Cup AND REMOVE the filter and insert a new folded filter (see the other side).
5		Fill the K-Cup with espresso ground coffee. Fill the K-Cup high or low depending on the strength of coffee you desire. You will need to experiment a little until you get the strength you like.
6		Insert the My-Kap kap on the inside top of the K-Cup snugly and brew <sup>2</sup> . Make sure the writing on the kap is up and on the outside of the K-Cup.
7		When you are done, enjoy your brew, remove the K-Cup and Kap (using the removal tool supplied) and start over with step 4.

<sup>1</sup> Let it dry before re-loading it with coffee or tea if you are not going to brew right away. Cleanliness of the K-Cup and My-Kap is your responsibility.

<sup>2</sup> Wash your Kap with warm soapy water before initial use and dry thoroughly. If this is the first time you have used the Kap in a K-Cup it might be tight and sit high. The K-Cup expands and the Kap fits lower in the cup after the first use.

## My-Kap® Filter Folding Instructions

Go to <http://www.my-kap.com/MYK/filters.html> and print out the instructions for making your own filters. You can make 200 filters in a matter of minutes.

4		Take one of the filter papers (you can make your own filter by following the directions on our web site).
5		Fold one edge over to meet the other edge.
6		Fold the edge where the two edges meet back about a 1/4 inch.
7		Fold the bottom up so that there is a flat area about the diameter of the bottom of a K-Cup. Don't worry, you do not have to be very precise.
8		Place the filter in the cup so that the hole in the bottom is oriented as shown. Don't put the paper on top of the hole. That is the main thing to watch for.
9		Open the filter up so that it fills the K-Cup. One folded edge should fit snugly against the edge of the K-Cup.
10		This shows a different view. You can see the filter paper is above the K-Cup edge just a little bit.
